The 2012 Annual Report and Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs) for the above-referenced facility in Industrial Sector A4 of the General Industrial Stormwater Permit were received 1/31/2013. The Annual Report has been determined to be in compliance with the applicable permit requirements. The following is a list of pollutants for which the facility has exceeded the benchmark values set for the stormwater runoff:

The purpose of the general permit is to encourage the industrial sector to find Best Management Practices (BMP's) that can be implemented without being mandated. By relaying this information to the industries, the Department hopes to significantly reduce the overall pollutant concentrations for Industrial Sector A4.
