This permit allows the permittee listed above to construct the wastewater treatment system in accordance with the permit application and plans and specifications which were received on March 28, 2025, with all additional information received by August 1, 2025, under authority of the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act (Arkansas Code Annotated § 8-4-101 et seq. and Arkansas Code Annotated § 8-4-201 et seq.) and the following terms and conditions.

- 1. The treatment system shall be constructed in accordance with the final plans and specifications as submitted to the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ). In case any statement or representation in the aforementioned documents is found to be incorrect, this approval may be revoked.
- 2. There shall be no deviation from the permitted plans and specifications unless the revisions have been submitted for review and written approval is received.
- 3. Within thirty (30) days of completion of the construction the permittee shall submit a Notice of Completion of Construction to the Division (Permits Branch of the Office of Water Quality) that the facility has been constructed in accordance with the approved plans and specifications. The certification shall be signed by the Responsible Official as well as stamped and signed by a Professional Engineer (P.E.) licensed in the state of Arkansas. - 4. This permit is issued in reliance upon the statements and representations made in the application and the plans and specifications. Issuance of this State Construction Permit does not guarantee satisfactory performance of the treatment system. The permittee shall ensure that water quality standards are not violated. Any modifications to the treatment facility necessary to meet water quality standards are the responsibility of the permittee and would require a modification to this State Construction Permit.
- 5. A State Construction Permit for a new wastewater treatment facility does not constitute an NPDES permit. Issuance of a State Construction Permit for construction of a treatment system in no way guarantees or assumes that an application for an NPDES permit to operate the system will be approved or an NPDES permit will be issued.
- 6. A complete "Operations and Maintenance (O&M) Manual" of the wastewater treatment system shall be developed by the facility consultant for the operator's use before the plant is in operation.
- 7. Failure to begin construction within one (1) year of the effective date may result in termination of this permit if a request for an extension is not submitted to the Division in a timely manner.

8. The permittee must submit notification of the start of construction within fifteen (15) days after construction has begun.

- 9. If a construction site will disturb greater than or equal to one (1) acre and less than five (5) acres, the permittee shall comply with the requirements in PC&EC Rule 6.203 for Stormwater discharge associated with a small construction site, as defined in PC&EC Rule 6. If the construction site will disturb five (5) acres or more, the permittee shall comply with the terms of the Stormwater Construction General Permit Number ARR150000 prior to the start of construction. BMPs must be implemented regardless of the size.
- 10. This facility is located as follows: Latitude: 35° 27' 46.64" N; Longitude: 93° 48' 16.24" W in Franklin County, Arkansas.
- 11. The receiving water for this facility is the Arkansas River in Segment 3H of the Arkansas River Basin. The outfall associated with this construction permit is located at the following coordinates: Outfall 003: Latitude: 35° 27' 43.99" N; Longitude: 93° 48' 21.89" W.
- 12. The construction will include: an oil/water separator, a retention pond with a vented 60-mil HDPE liner, leak detection pipe, and emergency overflow with a design flow of 0.15 MGD. There is no existing treatment system for this portion of the facility.

Biologists with the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission (AGFC) have reviewed the Public Notice for State Construction Permit No. AR0001759C1, AFIN 24-00012 for the Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation Thomas B. Fitzhugh Generating Station wastewater treatment system, located in Franklin County, Arkansas. Based on a desktop level review of the project and associated documentation, the AGFC recommends to consider limiting tree trimming and clearing to the bat inactive season (November 16 to March 14). The AGFC appreciates the opportunity to review this permit. Please don't hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or if I can be of further assistance.

Response: The timing of construction activities is outside the scope of DEQ's permitting review. DEQ encourages the permittee to coordinate construction scheduling with the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission.
