In accordance with 40 C.F.R.

§§ 403.11 and 403.18, the Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority gives the following notice:

The Little Rock Water Reclamation Authority (LRWRA) has proposed a substantial pretreatment program modification. LRWRA submitted the proposed modification on June 4, 2021, with all additional information received by July 8, 2021. The proposed modification has been reviewed by the DEQ's Office of water quality and has been deemed to meet the requirements of 40 C.F.R. § 403.9(b).

Comments on the proposed pretreatment program modifications will be accepted in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 403.11. DEQ's contact person for submitting written comments, or requesting a public hearing, is Zachary Carroll, at the above address and telephone number, or by email at Water-Draft-Permit-Comment@adeq.state.ar.us.

The period for submitting comments on the proposed pretreatment program modifications, and for requesting a public hearing, shall begin on the date of publication of the public notice, and end at 4:30 P.M. (Central Time) on the 30th day after the publication date. If the last day of the comment period is a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the public comment period shall expire on the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday. For information regarding the actual publication date along with the actual date and time the comment period will end, please contact Zachary Carroll at the above address and telephone number or by email at WaterDraftPermit-Comment@adeq.state.ar.us. All persons who wish to comment on the proposed pretreatment program modification must submit written comments to DEQ, along with their name and mailing address. A Public Hearing will be held if requested by LRWRA, or if DEQ finds a significant degree of public interest. If no comments are received during the comment period, DEQ may approve the modification request without further public notice in accordance with 40 C.F.R. § 403.18(c)(3).
