Allen,

Please find attached this facilities semi-annual report, we have opted to report electronically.

We are still working to isolate where the spike in our Zinc levels came from. The sump in the wash bay was not being cleaned regularly by the operators, so we cleaned it out last Friday and got them back on schedule. Our maintenance team worked yesterday and is working today to clean the inside of the holding tanks. I will pull a sample of effluent on Wednesday and overnight it to the lab, hopefully the results will be good news. I have the filter housing and cartridges in-house. If the third set of samples yields high Zinc levels, we will install the filter, and pull a fourth set of samples. Our vendor assures me that, based on the filters performance at other facilities, our levels will fall to well below the limit. I'm going to reserve the filter as my last option though. The housing is \$1,000.00 and the cartridges are \$300.00 each. If I can find the source of Zinc in the process and address or remove it there, I prefer to. I'll send an updated schematic to each of you if I have to install the filter.

I will share sampling results with each of you as I get them back. Please call if you need anything else at this time.
