I wanted to provide you an update. As I indicated in my e-mail dated March 15, 2012 (a copy of which is attached), there is still no wastewater treatment currently ongoing at the Wynne facility. The West building has now been totally demolished and the wastewater is still being removed by ASI out of Little Rock.

There has been no determination regarding restoration of future lineset or casting operations at the Wynne facility though the plastics manufacturing portion has been relocated to Portage, MI.

I will continue to keep you updated.

Allen:

I apologize for the long period of time which it took me to get back with you. I have been on the road constantly.

I finally ran down Mike Hollowell yesterday and verified that there is no wastewater treatment ongoing currently. The West building is being demolished which is where the wastewater treatment was setup. The insurance company and Mueller are currently negotiating on the relocation of the treatment. In the meantime, any water generated is being hauled off by ASI out of Little Rock.

Other than the plastic operation (which will not be relocated in Wynne), there has been no other determination about restoration of either the linesets or casting operations in Wynne.

I will keep you updated once a determination has been made regarding the resumption of discharge to the City of Wynne POTW.
