Chuck,

Thank you for the latest update after the fire that shut your plant down back in September of 2011.

When you know more about when your pretreatment system is functional, what processes under 40 CFRs 468 (Copper Forming) and/or 464 (Metal Molding) will remain, please advise this office and begin taking samples upon the day of wastewater discharged.

If your Copper Molding operations are to be relocated we will have to adjust your current Federal Pretreatment Standards accordingly.

As your semi-annual reports are due during the months of June and December of each year, if you are still not discharging regulated wastewater to the City by June, please submit in that report/statement something to affect, "There has been no regulated wastewater discharged to the City's sewage collection system since the September '11 fire. All regulated wastewater is currently being hauled off-site for disposal. A record of manifests will be kept on-site for review by regulatory entities."

This one page report/statement should also include (as with any Pretreatment Report to ADEQ) the signed certification statement, "I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering the information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate, and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations."

I wish you and Mueller all the best in coming fully back on-line.

Allen:

I apologize for the long period of time which it took me to get back with you. I have been on the road constantly.

I finally ran down Mike Hollowell yesterday and verified that there is no wastewater treatment ongoing currently. The West building is being demolished which is where the wastewater treatment was setup. The insurance company and Mueller are currently negotiating on the relocation of the treatment. In the meantime, any water generated is being hauled off by ASI out of Little Rock.

Other than the plastic operation (which will not be relocated in Wynne), there has been no other determination about restoration of either the linesets or casting operations in Wynne.

I will keep you updated once a determination has been made regarding the resumption of discharge to the City of Wynne POTW.
