Mena's General Manager (Charles Pitman - 479.394.2761) reported that their water account showed ~20 gallons/month(?) / day(?) used at the facility thinking this must reflect a leaky faucet. He had also heard (since the primary owner, Mark Campbell had passed on many months ago) Lisa Campbell had since placed her house on the market and moved to CA (correct me if I'm wrong Charles).

I have called and emailed S&P for over a several month period now with no one answering and no voice mail.

Charles was to have one of his employees try to gain entry into S&P's process bldg, but this office has not heard back from him on this attempt/report.

It's my concern S&P's process tanks/storage containers may still contain hazardous waste on-site. Have you any information to the contrary?

Just not wanting to see another hazardous waste clean-up site with ADEQ saddling the responsibility.
