Response to May 17, 2012 Pretreatment Program Audit:

1. Elements of a Pretreatment Program, Identification of Industrial Users

Currently we are compiling a master list(*Attachment 1*) of potential (IUs) located within the jurisdiction of the City of Magnolia sanitary collection system. This has been accomplished by requesting a Commercial Business/industry water usage report information from the Water office.(*Attachment 2*) Other information has been gather though ADEQ web site data base(Arkansas Hazardous Waste Generators Facility Summary) and the Manufacturers News. Within the next 60 -90 days we will be mailing a Non-domestic wastewater discharge questionnaire (attachment 3) to the Industrial/commercial facilities, after we have we have received the questionnaires been returned we will determine our significant users in the jurisdiction of the City of Magnolia.

2. Administrative Procedures:

After all the information is collected, permit is issued, and monitoring reports are sent in, we will be recording results and comparing them to the permit limits.

3. General:

A monitoring and sampling program will be put in place once we are online with the Pretreatment program.

4. Ordinance # 95-12 Section 3.2: Accidental Discharge/Slug Control Plans

The City will start conducting this inspection once every two years of their Industrial users once the program is back in place. Will submit changes to City Attorney to amend Ord #95-12.

5. Ordinance # 95-12 Section 10.0 Publication of Users in Significant Non-Compliance of Pretreatment Program.

Will start after program is back in affect.



6. Wastewater Discharge Permits”, Section 6.1 “Permit Applications:

We will require an industry to apply for a permit prior to them being issued a permit.

7. Ordinance # 95-12, Section 3.6, Wastewater Discharge Permit Duration:

This will be submitted to the City Attorney for amendment to the ordinance to read “A Wastewater discharge will be issued for a five year period .

8. Organization and Staffing:

This issue will be addressed as the City Council and funding allows, we already have a man dedicated for the lab and one for collecting samples.

C: Recommended program modifications to the City’s Pretreatment Program to bring the program to bring the program more in-line with the letter of its current Pretreatment Program.

Recommendations 1,2,and 3 will be turned over to the City Attorney for Amendments to Ordinance # 95-12. Will not be able to give you a time line on this, I do not know how long this will take the City Attorney and it will have to be presented to the City Council for approval.
