ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- 7. This permit shall expire when the approximate 15 acre disposal area described in the final engineering plans has been filled to design capacity.
- 8. Proper preparation of the site shall be supervised and reported in writing to the Department by a Registered Professional Engineer prior to placement of any waste in the landfill.
- 9. Waste to be deposited in this facility shall consist of the paper waste as described in the narrative.
- 10. The previous disposal site occupying this area will be closed out according to the submitted plans and narrative before this site can be utilized.
- 11. Waste is to be compacted daily and covered with 6" of acceptable clay weekly. District field inspector will require daily cover if adverse conditions develop from this practice. Surfaces that will not receive an additional depth of refuse or final cover within 60 days will be covered with a one (1) foot layer of clay.
- 12. As an adjunct to the additional conditions listed above, the permittee is reminded that the provisions of Condition #1 of this permit shall also be satisfied in the construction, operation, and maintenance of the landfill.
