Your Waste Tire Processing Permit will expire on February 28, 1996. As you may already know, a permitted processing facility is required to submit a Waste Tire Processing Facility Annual Report by March 1, 1996.

Any renewal information received after this date will be assessed a \$10.00 late charge. Inaccurate and incomplete application packages will be returned without being processed.

Owners and operators of waste tire processing facilities shall submit to the Department an annual report, by March 1, 1996, that includes the following information on Form TP5 (Waste Tire Processing Facility Annual Report - Attached):

- 1. The facility name, address and permit number;
- The year covered by the report;
- 3. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires received at the facility during the year covered by the report;
- 4. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires shipped from the facility during the year covered by the report;
- 5. The general disposition of waste tires or processed tires;
- 6. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires located at the facility on the first day of the calendar year;
- 7. The total quantity of tires **sold** from the facility as used tires during the year covered by the report; and
- 8. The most recent closure cost estimate prepared using the criteria in Section 11 of Regulation Number 14 (Waste Tire Site Requirements Attached).
- 9. Annual permit fee of \$100.00

The following additional materials specifically related to 3-WTP are also required by March 1, 1996:

- a. An approved contingency plan allowing the shipment of excess waste tires to another permitted facility should this facility violate waste tire storage requirements, permit conditions and/or close their business.
- b. A completed Form TP1 Waste Tire Site Notification.
- c. A notarized Disclosure Statement.
