Dear Mr. Holcomb:

In accordance with Regulation 14 (Regulations and Administrative Procedures), please provide the following to the Solid Waste Division:

- 1. As required by Section 14.4, a waste tire processing facility annual report (Form TP 5 Included) that summarizes the information collected under Section 14.3 should be submitted to the Department, along with the following information:
 - A. The facility name, address, and permit number.
 - B. The year covered by the report.
 - C. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires received at the facility during the year covered by the report.
 - D. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires shipped from the facility during the year covered by the report.
 - E. The general disposition of waste tires or processed tires.
 - F. The total quantity and type of waste tires or processed tires located at the facility on the first day of the calendar year.
- 2. Annual Permit Fee of \$100.00 per waste tire processing facility.
- 3. You should also submit the most recent closure cost estimate, to be approved by the Department. The costs shall be based on a third party performing the work and reported on a per unit basis.

You will need to provide the Department with proof of financial responsibility issued in favor of the Arkansas Department of Pollution Control and Ecology in the amount of such approved estimate for closure of the facility.

4. You will find enclosed a list of permitted collection centers with your respective counties highlighted. If you are responsible for the management of collection centers in your district, make any and all corrections, changes, and additions.

As required by Section 12.5, you will also need to complete the enclosed Form TP 8 by providing the number of tires received and processed during the period (03/01/96 thru 02/28/97) and the sites where the tires were shipped for disposal or recycling. The completed Form TP8 should be returned with the permit renewal fee of \$25.00 per collection center location.

These items should be received at the Department no later than March 7, 1997.
