ADEQ Solid Waste Management Division staff has reviewed the revised minor permit modification application for the Waste Management of Arkansas Tontitown Transfer Station (TTS) dated June 27, 2008. Currently the TTS is under the general Solid Waste Permit Number 0023-STSW-MC for medium capacity solid waste transfer stations. This minor permit modification application has been presented to ADEQ on an individual solid waste permit application form. Therefore, the review of this application has been conducted using the requirements of Regulation 22, Chapter 9, in addition to the requirements outlined in Section C, Notice of Intent, of general permit 0023-STSW-MC. The deficiencies presented below are results of the review of the revised application, and include some of the same items as previously listed in the NOD letter dated March 11, 2008.

- 1) APC&EC Regulation 22.903(b)(2) requires a map or aerial photographs be submitted indicating land use and zoning within ½ mile of the facility showing such elements as residences, structures, surface waters, public and private water supply sources, access roads, railroads, airports, and historical sites. The submitted revised permit application does reference a Site Map, but the Site Map could not be located. Please submit the referenced Site Map.
- 2) APC&EC Regulation 22.903(b)(5) requires a description of the service area population (both present and projected). Narrative concerning the service area population could not be located in the revised permit application submittal. Please review and revise as necessary.

- 3) The narrative in the revised application submittal states the waste will immediately be placed into transfer trailers or roll-off containers and hauled offsite once the containers are full. If waste is stored onsite it would be in transfer trailers or roll-offs and covered. APC&EC Regulation 22.905(b)(5) still requires sufficient internal storage be provided for incoming solid waste. Project plans and specifications should be submitted for internal storage. Please review and revise as necessary.
