Dear Ms. Rotenberry:

The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality-Solid Waste Management Division has received and reviewed the revised Operating Plan for the Eco-Vista, LLC compost facility. The revised operating plan states that non-treated wood debris from home construction and demolition will be stored on site and ground once per quarter. The resulting wood chips will be mixed with other composted material and used as daily cover for the landfill located on the property.

The revised operating plan does not describe how the construction and demolition waste is received at the site or how it is separated or sorted. Please provide further details regarding this issue. Also, it is a concern that C & D material will be stored on site for at least three months at a time before the material is chipped and mixed with composted material. Please provide the estimated amount of waste that is expected to be received, processed and stored at any given time. A more detailed operating plan describing the proposed activity is requested in order to evaluate and determine if it is exempt from C & D Recovery Facility permitting requirements.
