

3.0 PROCESSED QUANTITIES

In addition to compost, this facility produces mulch (ground hard and soft wood). The scale house tracks the total tons of finished products (compost and mulch) removed from the site, the inert reject material that is sorted out and disposed of in the Class 1 landfill, and the yard and tree waste received at the facility. In addition, CLR tracks the tons of ground yard waste utilized as alternate daily cover (ADC) at the Class 1 landfill. The graph below shows the tonnage handled for the 2019 calendar year. The facility received 24,200 tons of yard waste during 2019. Of that, 16,545 tons of product was disposed in the Class 1 landfill; 5,497 tons were used as alternative daily cover on the Class 1 landfill; and 2,158 tons were recycled or sold (see Appendix C).



5.0 PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE OPERATING PLAN

No changes in the current method of operations were required.

6.0 STORMWATER CONTROLS

Stormwater controls are in place and functioning. On October 25, 2006, DEQ issued NPDES Industrial Stormwater General Permit (IGP) No. ARR000220, and the most recent permit renewal was issued July 1, 2019. The IGP Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP), facility inspections, discharge monitoring results and reports, including the Stormwater Annual Report (SWAR), are included in the facility operating record to be made available to DEQ upon request.

The NPDES permit allows the discharge of the CLR composting runoff pond into "waters of the United States." On November 7, 2006, CLR began discharging the compost runoff pond into a ditch located just north of the pond. As a backup system, stormwater from the compost runoff pond can be diverted to the leachate pond or directly to the City's sewer line.

7.0 CORRECTIVE ACTIONS

The inspections performed by ADEQ during the present reporting period resulted in two Category 2 violations. A routine inspection on March 5, 2019 resulted in a Category 2 violation regarding \$22.806(a)(2) and \$22.806(b)(3) of Regulation No. 22. (listed as "Adequate composting area surface, slope and drainage" on the inspection form). Standing water was observed on the compost pad. In response to this violation, the facility made repairs to the low area where the water was standing. A routine inspection on November 25, 2019 resulted in a Category 2 violation regarding \$22.805 of Regulation 22 (listed as "Operations in accordance with permit documents" on the inspection form). The compost grinder had been non-functional for 6 months. During the April 03, 2020 site visit, the grinder was in use.
