FOR CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF
A YARD WASTE COMPOSTING FACILITY
(TYPE Y COMPOSTING FACILITY)
ISSUED BY STATE OF ARKANSAS
DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY**

PERMIT NUMBER: 0000-SCYW

AUTHORITY: In accordance with the provisions of the Arkansas Solid Waste Management Act (Act 237 of 1971 as amended; Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated §8-6-201 *et seq.*), and the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APC&EC) Rule No. 22, the Division has the authority to issue general permits for certain categories of solid waste processing facilities. Pursuant to that authority, the Division has chosen to permit Type Y composting facilities through a general permit program.

EFFECTIVE DATE: October 2, 2017

MODIFICATION DATE: October 11, 2022 – Effective as of October 2, 2022

EXPIRATION DATE: May 31, 2023

LIMITATIONS: Owners or operators of Type Y composting facilities within the State of Arkansas who fail to make a written request to the Administrator to be covered by this general permit or those who fail to submit all required documentation are not authorized to operate under the permit.
