In response to your inspection of November 8, 2022, the following is a list of comments and corrective actions to be undertaken on the City of Little Rock's Compost Site:

Compost Site, Permit # 0031 – SCYW

- **Category 1, Regulation 805(b)(2): Confirm to Operating Plan.** Document #81838 describes the compost yard as a 20 – acre asphalt paved site where aerobic compost occurs. This document also states, in part, no changes in the current method of operations were required. Comment: The western half of the asphalt pad is no longer present and operations have had to be moved to eastern portion of the pad. The City is currently in the process of revising our Operation Plan and planning to rehab the compost yard so it is properly sloped and is capable of supporting heavy equipment.
- **Category 2, Regulation 806(a)(2): Adequate Composting Area Surface.** The composting area is not sloped to prevent ponding of water in depressions and the western composting pad is vegetated with very little asphalt. This prevents using it for composting operations. The City is in the process of rehabbing the compost area to prevent ponding of water and revising our Operations Plan to possibly remove this area from our permitted composting area.
