The Division of Environmental Quality Office of Land Resources (DEQ) has reviewed the October 2022 Explosive Gas Monitoring Memo dated April 12, 2023. DEQ has the following comment:

- The report includes a calibration sheet at the end of the document. However, there's no date displaying when the calibration occurred. In the past, reports included a row of data showing a calibration sample. The manual for the gas sampling equipment mentions that calibration should occur every 1-3 months. DEQ requests that a calibration is performed immediately prior to sampling at Nabors.
