Good afternoon! Blake Small just notified that an individual brought in a personal boat for disposal at Class 4, and as they were unloading the boat, it ignited and caught fire. The boat was not at the workface, but was being unloaded in a separate area so not to impede the Class 4 traffic flow. The landfill operators extinguished the fire immediately with water and soil. The Tontitown Fire Chief, Mark Ramsey, was in the area and came to the site in response, but the local fire department was not needed.

The site manager is collecting information from the disposers of the boat. The boat was left at the landfill in a segregated area and will be placed in Class 4 once deemed safe.
