Dear Mr. Knight:

On April 24, 2009, I performed an investigation of your facility in response to a complaint. The complaint alleged that oil and auto fluids were possibly running off into a creek. I found the complaint to be invalid. However, this investigation revealed that you are in violation of the Federal Clean Water Act, the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act, and the regulations promulgated thereunder. Specifically, I found the following violation: a required Industrial Storm Water Permit has not been obtained. You must notify Jamal Solaimanian of the Water Division Permits Branch of this Department at 501-682-0620 and submit an application for an Industrial Storm Water Permit.

The above item requires your immediate attention. Please submit a written response to this finding to Cindy Garner, Technical Assistance Manager of the Water Division Enforcement Branch of this Department. This response should contain documentation describing the course of action taken to correct the item noted. This corrective action should be completed as soon as possible, and the written response is due by May 21, 2009.

I informed Ricochet that he would need an industrial storm water permit. He thought he only needed a permit if he had more than 200 vehicles, he keeps less than 100 on site. I informed him that he would still need a permit and that the expired permit required sampling for over 200 vehicles. I gave him Amanda Gallagher's name and phone number and he said he was about to leave for a motorcycle rally and would call the following week to obtain a permit. The site appeared to be kept clean; I did not see any oil or auto fluids running off of the property.
