This is to give notice that the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality, Post Office Box 8913, Little Rock, Arkansas 72219-8913 proposes a draft renewal of the permit for which an application was received on July 24, 2006 for the following applicant under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and the Arkansas Water and Air Pollution Control Act.

This is a renewal of the existing NPDES discharge permit.

208 Plan (Water Quality Management Plan)

The 208 Plan, developed by the ADEQ under provisions of Section 208 of the federal Clean Water Act, is a comprehensive program to work toward achieving federal water goals in Arkansas. The initial 208 Plan, adopted in 1979, provides for annual updates, but can be revised more often if necessary. Updates to the 208 Plan have been proposed to include the following water quality limitations and other information for the above discharger to the receiving stream listed below

May-October: November-April: CBOD5/TSS/NH3-N/D0= 15/20/5/3 mg/l CBOD5/TSS/ NH3-N/D0= 20/20/12/2 mg/l

Design flow:

0.025 MGD 0 cfs

Facility Location: The facility is located as follows: I-530 East to Old Warren Road exit turn right (southeast), then turn left (south) at Town And Country Store on middle Warren Road, go straight south approximately 2.5 miles, turn left (east) on gravel road across from Chamber Wood Road; Latitude: 34° 08' 47"; Longitude: 92° 01' 45" in Section 5, Township 7 South, Range 9 West in Jefferson County, Arkansas.

Discharge Location: The discharge from this existing facility is made into Boggy Bayou, thence into Bayou Bartholomew, thence into the Arkansas River in Segment 2B of the Arkansas River Basin. The receiving stream is a Water of the State classified for secondary contact recreation; raw water source for public, industrial, and agricultural water supplies; propagation of desirable species of fish and other aquatic life;

Outfall Location: The outfall is located at the following coordinates: Latitude: 34° 08' 47" Longitude: 92° 01' 43".

.303(d) List Consideration: The receiving stream (Boggy Bayou) is not on the 303(d) List. However Bayou Bartholomew, which is located approximately 5 miles downstream of the discharge point, is on the 2004 303(d) List in Category 4a for silitation, and the sources of such pollutants are agricultural activities. Based on Page 18 of the water quality report WQ-D1-04-01 dated April 2001, the discharge from Boggy Bayou Sewer Improvement District is probably not having any effect on the Bayou Bartholomew. Thus, no permit action is need at this time.

Endangered Species Consideration: No comments on the application were received from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USF&WS). The draft permit and Statement of Basis will be sent to the USF&WS for their review.

Type of Treatment: extended aeration activated sludge, clarifier, sand filters, and chlorine disinfection.

Sludge Condition: Sludge is hauled off site as necessary by a licensed septic tank hauler.

Activity: Under the standard industrial classification (SIC) code 4952, the applicant's activities are the operation of a municipal treatment

Changes: Changes from the previously issued permit are listed below. The permittee is responsible for carefully reading the permit in detail and becoming familiar with all of the changes therein:

- Parts II, III, and IV have been revised.

 The pH limits were revised from 6-9 s.u. to (3.0 9.0 s.u.

 The facility mailing address has changed.

 CB0D5 monthly average concentration and mass limits for May-October have been decreased. The facility narrative location description has been expanded.

 Ammonia-Nitrogen daily maximum concentration limits for May-March have been changed.

 Ammonia-Nitrogen concentration and mass limits for April have changed.

 A D0 limit for November-April has been added to the perwit.

 The minimum operator class has been specified as Class II.

 The facility name has changed.

 Dissolved Downen (D0 has changed from an instantaneous minimum to a monthly average minimum.)

- Dissolved Oxygen (D0) has changed from an instantaneous minimum to a monthly average minimum.
 The facility coordinates have been revised based on the ADEQ PDS facility gate coordinates.

Public Notice: In accordance with Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (APCEC) Regulation No. 8, the public notice will be published by ADEQ in a newspaper of general circulation on or before March 9, 2007 for one (1) day only. Comments must be received at ADEQ prior to the close of the public comment period April 9, 2007. The public comment period will begin on the date of publication and will enk no

A draft permit and draft public notice will be sent to the District Engineer, Corps of Engineers, and to the Regional Director of the USF&WS on a case-by-case basis, and the EPA and Arkansas Department of Health prior to the publication of that notice.

Issuance of the Final Permit: The permit will become effective on or after May 1, 2007 unless comments are received and/or public hearing is requested prior to April 9, 2007, in which case the permit will be effective on or after June 1,2007.

Comments: and Public Hearing: NPDES comments and public hearing procedures may be found at 40 CFFI Parts 124.10 through 124.12 and APCEC Regulation No. 8. All persons, including the permittee, who wish to comment on ADEQ's draft permitting decision must submit written comments to ADEQ, along with their name and mailing address. During the comment period, any interested person may request a public hearing by filing a written request which must state the technical issues to be raised. A public hearing will be held if ADEQ finds a significant degree of public interest. If a public hearing is held, ADEQ will issue a public notice of the hearing at least 30 days prior ito the scheduled hearing.

After the public comment period, and public hearing, if one is held, ADEQ will issue a final permitting decision. ADEQ will notify the applicant and each person who has submitted written comments or requested notice of the final permitting decision. A final permitting decision means a final decision to issue, deny, modify, revoke and reissue, or terminate a permit. Any interested person who has submitted comments may appeal a final decision by ADEQ in accordance with the APCEC Regulation N.o. 8 (Administrative Procedures).

Submitting written comments to ADEQ or making oral statements on the record at the public hearing on the proposed permitting decision provides individuals with legal standing to appeal a final Department permitting decision. Comments supporting or opposing the proposed decision will provide legal standing. Only parties with legal standing may appeal a permitting decision.




