AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 PROVIDES FUNDS FOR LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

President Joe Biden signed the American Rescue Plan Act into law on March 11, 2021, in response to a difficult 2020 that was plagued by COVID-19 and accompanying economic and social woes. In addition to efforts to battle COVID-19, the far sweeping \$1.9 trillion dollar relief Act will provide aid to a vast array of programs and government agencies, as well as directly to American families. One program that will receive funding from the legislation is the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP).

LIHEAP, which assists low income households with heating costs during the winter and cooling costs during the summer, is expected to receive \$33 million via LIHEAP block grant funds to states and territories. In Arkansas, LIHEAP is operated by a network of fifteen Community Action Agencies (CAAs) which serves all seventy-five counties.
