	2. Can the start date of the grant be changed to the actual date the grant is awarded?	2. The subgrant effective date of July 1, 2024 allows funds to be spent as of that date, once DOE approves the grant application, for eligible expenses that may have been incurred prior to the subgrant award. This maximizes the effective period of the subgrant.
