## What's all the fuss about coffee grounds?

Coffee grounds are one of the best natural soil additives available, being relatively high in nitrogen (similar to grass clippings), and when added

to a compost bin will speed up decomposition and give you beautiful, black, rich compost.

Coffee grounds also help keep away slugs, ants, snails and cats. Even better, they attract earthworms to your garden in large numbers.
