

# Business Assistance Program

ADEQ's mission is to protect, enhance, and restore the environment for the well-being of all Arkansans.

## Small Business Environmental Loans

ADEQ provides low-interest loans to Arkansas businesses for environmental projects. The loans are available to companies that can show profitability with fewer than 100 employees. Eligible activities include:

### **Environmental Compliance**

**Projects** to correct or avoid violations of state or federal environmental regulations.

#### **Pollution Prevention Projects**

to reduce or eliminate the generation of pollution or waste at the source.

Waste Reduction Projects to handle or process waste materials in such a way that ultimately reduces the total quantity of waste disposed.

# Compliance Assistance

## **Environmental Compliance Audits**

ADEQ's Business Assistance Program (BAP) staff can analyze a facility's industrial processes, research regulatory requirements and inform the facility of its compliance status.

### **Direct Technical and Compliance Assistance**

BAP staff can recommend compliance measures and help implement measures if necessary. They can help identify other sources for assistance within ADEQ or other environmental agencies and through non-governmental agencies.

## Regulatory Liaison Service

BAP staff will act as a liaison for facilities that are involved in permit issues with a regulatory division of ADEQ or the United States Environmental Protection Agency. BAP staff operates in a strictly non-regulatory role, arranging meetings, monitoring regulatory operations on behalf of the facility and explaining the regulatory process as it proceeds.

## **Permit Assistance**

#### **Permit Analysis**

BAP staff will analyze a facility's processes to determine if it is required to have environmental permits from ADEQ. The staff will explain obligations and recommend methods of applying for required permits.

#### **Permit Preparation Assistance**

BAP staff can help a facility identify information that must be submitted with an application and offer advice and assistance for preparing it. If the facility desires, BAP staff can arrange a meeting for regulatory division staff to meet with facility representatives to discuss permit needs.

#### **Permit Tracking**

BAP staff will help a facility track the status of a permit application, acting as a facility liaison to the ADEQ regulatory divisions.

## **Pollution Prevention**

Pollution Prevention Research and Assistance BAP staff will help a facility find pollution prevention opportunities. The staff will research options recommend pollution prevention

options, recommend pollution prevention measures, and provide technical assistance to help a facility institute the measures.

# Commercial Property Redevelopment

ADEQ's Brownfields Program encourages renewed use of abandoned or underdeveloped properties with real or perceived environmental contamination. The program establishes use-specific cleanup levels, offers liability releases for new property owners and provides low-interest loans to help communities return sites to productive use.

# Business Solid Waste Management

#### **Solid Waste Audits**

BAP staff will conduct onsite audits of a facility's solid waste. The staff will analyze the waste and recommend options for source reduction, waste re-use and recycling.

#### Waste Management Assistance

BAP staff will help a facility develop and implement a waste management plan to help the facility reduce its waste volume, improve waste handling and/or reduce waste handling costs.

#### **Waste Marketing**

BAP staff will help a facility market its waste materials as recyclable products, or identify recyclables that can be incorporated into its products, when appropriate.

# **Recycling Tax Credits**

#### **Income Tax Credits**

ADEQ offers a 30-percent Arkansas State Income Tax Credit redeemable over four years for the purchase of equipment used to recycle wastes for the manufacture of new products.

#### **Waste Marketing and Procurement**

BAP staff can help a facility identify waste materials to incorporate into facility recycling to meet the post-consumer content requirement.
