Accomplishments:

Increased yield of marketable recyclables from the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) by 2% from 2015 to 2016. Reduced the residual rate between 2015 and 2016 from 13% to 11%. Reduced workplace injuries within the MRF by 55% from 2015 to 2016.



Challenges:

Contamination, including sharps and scrap metal, in the single stream recycling program. Equipment failures resulting from contamination. Fewer and tighter markets available to purchase recyclables.

Plans:

Continuing educational outreach programs for the community to help increase knowledge and awareness of the single stream recycling program. Maintaining our commitment to promote a clean and litter-free environment. The department commits time every week to collect litter around our facility

as well as a 3 mile stretch of U.S. Highway 64 within the city of Conway. Continuous improvement of the safety program. The department is committed to meeting the demands of the ever changing recycling markets while providing a responsible curbside recycling service to the community.
