Great Lakes Chemical Company (GLCC) filed a petition for third-party rulemaking to amend Regulation No. 2 "Regulation Establishing Water Quality Standards for Surface Waters of the State of Arkansas." (Petition No. 02-004-R.)

Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Minute Order No. 02-06 authorized the initiation of rulemaking. One public hearing and a 45-day public comment period were held. The Statement and Basis and Purpose as well as the Responsiveness Summary were prepared for Commission review.

It is therefore, ORDERED:

- 1. That a site specific protective temperature criterion of 96°F be promulgated for the 0.5 mile reach of Bayou de Loutre from the point where GLCC's Outfall 001 discharges into Bayou de Loutre to the confluence with Loutre Creek.
- 2. That the Statement of Basis and Purpose and the Responsiveness Summary submitted by GLCC and the Statement of Basis and Purpose and the Responsiveness Summary submitted by ADEQ are adopted by the Commission as part of this rulemaking proceeding.
  - 3. That the ADEQ staff is directed to make these changes to Regulation No. 2.
