Several weeks ago I spoke to you concerning an error that was brought to my attention by the Bayou Meto Water Management District ("Bayou Meto"). Bayou Meto filed a third party petition to revise the water quality standards on a number of streams in its district. Following notice to the public, public hearing, and legislative review of the proposed rule, the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission ("Commission") adopted the revised water quality standards for those streams. Bayou Meto then sent an incorrect list of streams to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality and that list was included in the Regulation No. 2 that was filed with you as the final rule on November 15, 2007.

Pages A-40 and A-41 of Regulation No. 2 includes four streams that should not have been included in the regulation. Those four streams are: Brooks Branch, Buck Creek, Faras Run, and Lonoke Ditch. The Commission did not change the standards on these four streams. However, the Commission did adopt new water quality standards for Plum Bayou, Brownsville Branch, and Eagle Branch and these three streams were not listed on pages A-40 and A-41 of the regulation as they should have been.

Public notice of Bayou Meto's rulemaking was published on May 10 and 11, 2007, and it listed Plum Bayou, Brownsville Branch, and Eagle Branch. The public notice did not list Brooks Branch, Buck Creek, Faras Run, or Lonoke Ditch. A copy of the public notice is attached for your review.

On October 26, 2007, the Commission adopted the correct list of streams including Plum Bayou, Brownsville Branch, and Eagle Branch as set out in the Commission's Minute Order No. 07-41. A copy of Minute Order 07-41 is attached for your review. Please note that the Minute Order does not list Brooks Branch, Buck Creek, Faras Run, or Lonoke Ditch.
