Assuming the proposed rule is approved by the Commission and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"), the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality ("ADEQ") will be able to rely on the revised criteria to amend Huntsville's National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System ("NPDES") permit limits for minerals to reflect historical levels in the effluent, levels that Huntsville has demonstrated that it can meet consistently. Huntsville will therefore be positively impacted by the proposal. No entities would suffer negative economic impact as a result of the proposed rule. The total estimated cost for Huntsville to implement the proposed rule through permitting is unknown, but is unlikely to be significant.
