The ADEQ Office of Water Quality has completed the review of SWEPCO's proposed site specific criteria revisions to Reg. 2.511(A) and supporting documentation regarding TDS criteria for the Red River from its confluence with the Little River to the Arkansas-Louisiana state line.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) disapproved a previous proposed rulemaking on July 20, 2016. Subsequently, SWEPCO provided EPA supplemental information to demonstrate protection of the aquatic life use in Red River and indicated it would seek another rulemaking proceeding to revise the site specific TDS criterion to 780 mg/L, which is a reduction from the previous proposal of 860 mg/L.

The Office of Water Quality has reviewed this request and supplemental proposal and has no objections to SWEPCO moving forward with initiating the third-party rulemaking process with the Arkansas Pollution Control & Ecology Commission (APC&EC).
