HEARING
The Arkansas Pollution Control
and Ecology Commission (APCEC)
will hold a public hearing in Harrison on June 17, 2014, to receive
comments on a third-party proposal by the Ozark Society and
the Arkansas Public Policy Panel
(Petitiloners) to change APCEC
Regulations 5 and 6, entitled Liquid Animal Waste Systems and
Regulations for State Administration of the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System, respectively. APCEC will begin the
hearing at 6:00 p.m. in the Durand Conference Center, Room A,
at North Arkansas College, 303 N.
Main St., Harrison, AR 72601.
APCEC may postpone the
hearing due to inclement weather
or unforeseen circumstances. If
postponed, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality
(ADEQ) will issue and publish a
new legal notice to announce a
new hearing date, place, and
comment period.
The deadline for submitting
written comments on the proposed changes is 4:30 p.m.
(Central Time), July 1, 2014.
APCEC Regulation 8, entitled
Administrative Procedures, Sections 8,809-8,811 and Ark. Code
Ann. Section 8-4-202 (c) provide
that outside parties may petition
APCEC to initiate rulemaking to
adopt or amend APCEC Regulations. Ark. Code Ann. Section
8-4-201 et seq. authorizes APCEC
to amend APCEC Regulations 5,
and 6.

to amend APČEC Regulations 5 and 6.

APČEC's order to initiale rule-making does not constitute an endorsement of the proposed changes to APČEC Will adopt or reject the proposed changes after Pelitioners and ADEO respond to comments submitted during the public comment period.

The proposed changes to APČEC Regulations 5 and 6 seek to prohibit the ADEO Director from issuing Regulation No. 5 permits for Confined Animal Operations, and Regulation No. 5 permits for Concentrated Animal Peeding Operations, for facilities in the Buffalo National River Watershed with either 750 or more swine weighing 55 pounds or more, or 3,000 or more swine weighing than 55 pounds. The proposed regulation changes do not impact the status of existing facilities. The regulation changes will norbibits an increase in the numfiles. The regulation changes will prohibit an increase in the num-ber of swine at existing facilities in the Buffalo National River Wa-tershed.

Detailed copies of the proposed regulation change, along with supporting documents and summary information, are available for public inspection during normal business hours in the Public Outreach and Assistance Division, located on the second floor of ADEO's North Little Rock Office, and in ADEO information depositories located in public libraries at Clinton, Fayetteville, Fort Smith, Harrison, Mountain Home, Russellville, the main branch of the Little Rock Public Library, 100 Rock Street, and the Arkansas Stale Library, 900 West Capitol, Sulte 100, Little Rock, AR. In addition, summary information concerning the proposal is available at other ADEO information depositories located in public libraries at Arkadelphia, Batesville, Blytheville, Camden, Crossett, El Dorado, Forrest City, Helena, Hope, Hot Springs, Jonesboro, Magnolia, Monticello, Mena, Pocahontas, Searcy, Stuttgart, Texarkana, and West Memphis; and in campus libraries at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff and the University of Central Arkansas at Conway.
