NOTICE OF PROPOSED THIRD-PARTY RULEMAKING, PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (PC&EC) will hold public hearings at North Little Rock and Perryville, Arkansas, in May and June of 2008 to receive com-

Hock and Perryville, Arkansas, it way and June of 2008 to receive comments on a third-party proposal by Central Arkansas Water (CAW) to change PC&EC Regulation No.6, which deals with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) in Arkansas. The North Little Rock hearing will begin at 2:00 p.m. May 27, 2008, in the Commission Room at the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) headquarters building, 5301 Northshore Drive. The Perryville hearing will be held at 6:00 p.m. June 2, 2008, in the Perryville High School Cafeteria, 325 Houston Street.

Sections 3.4.1 through 3.4.4 of PC&EC Regulation No. 8 (Administrative Procedures), and the Arkansas Code, Annotated, Section 8.4.202(c) provide that outside parties may petiter the arman per procedures.

provide that outside parties may peti-tion the PC&EC to initiate the ruletion the PC&EC to initiate the rule-making process to adopt or amend regulations under the PC&EC is juris-diction. Commission authority to amend Regulation No. 6 is found in Arkansas Code Annotated, Section 8-4-202 et seq.
The fact that the PC&EC has

agreed to initiate such a third-party rulemaking procedure does not con-stitute an endorsement of the pro-posal at this time. The PC&EC will de-cide whether to adopt the proposed changes after the conclusion of the public comment period for the proposal and after CAW and the ADEQ staff respond to all public comments

submitted.
The ADEQ administers the NPDES The ADEQ administers the NPDES program in Arkansas, under delega-tion from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), by issuing permits for wastewater discharges to the waters of the state, and monitoring and enforcing permit conditions

and operations.

CAW proposes to change Regulation 6 by adding language which would prohibit all surface discharges of wastewater, except storm water discharges permitted under the NPDES program, into the Lake Maumelle Basin. Lake Maumelle serves as the public drinking water viscoly sources for the water. supply source for the distribution system operated by CAW, which serves 17 cities and communities in the central Arkansas area. The Lake Maumelle Basin includes portions of Pulaski, Perry, and Saline Counties.

Detailed copies of the proposed regulation change, along with support documents and summary information, are available for public inspection during normal business hours in the Public Outreach and Assistance Division, iceated on the second floor of the ADEQIs North Little Rock office, and in ADEQ information depositories located in the main branch of the located in the main branch of the Little Rock Public Library, 100 Rock Street, and in the Arkansas State

Little Rock Public Library, 100 Rock Street, and in the Arkansas State Library located on the State Capitol grounds at Little Rock. A full set of documents for the proposal also will be available for public inspaction during normal business hours at the Max Milam Branch of the Central Arkansas Library System, 609 Aplin Avenue, in Pernyville.

In addition, summary information concerning the proposal is available at other ADEQ information depositories located in public libraries at Arkadelphia, Batesville, Blytheville, Camden, Clinton, Crossett, El Dorado, Fayetteville, Terrest City, Fort Smith, Harrison, Helena, Hope, Hot Springs, Jonesboro, Magnotia, Mena, Monticello, Mountain Home, Pocahonfas, Russellville, Searcy, Stuttgart, Texarkana, and West Memphis; and in campus libraries at the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff and the University of Central Arkansas at Conway.
