The ADEQ Office of Water Quality has reviewed City of Fayetteville's proposed site-specific criteria revisions to Reg. 2.511(A) and supporting documentation proposing to split segment 023 below Noland Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The City has proposed revised criteria for the White River from the outfall of Noland WWTP for 0.4 miles downstream criteria of 44 mg/L chloride, 79 mg/L sulfate, and 362 mg/L TDS. Proposed criteria for the remaining portion of the White River to the confluence with Richland Creek are 30 mg/L chloride, 40 mg/L sulfate, and 237 mg/L TDS. ADEQ understands the proposed modifications will require the City to public notice the revised proposed criteria.

The Office of Water Quality has reviewed the supplemental information and has no objections to the City of Fayetteville moving forward with the proposed rulemaking using the revised proposed criteria.
