Please do not allow any CAFO's in the Buffalo River Watershed. The flooding in the Carolina's a few years ago should alert you to the potential catastrophe that could happen in our communities & rivers near CAFO's. Drive through the country side & you will see many empty & dilapidated chicken houses. You will also cringe at the smell of the active chicken houses. How would you like to have a CAFO right across the street from your home or cabin with the waste running into a creek right behind you? Any permitted CAFO should be required to have a sewage treatment plant like the one on the Illinois River. Even so, I still wouldn't want to live near one & I still wouldn't want to swim in the Illinois River.
