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Summary of Proposed Rule

- a. Significant revisions are proposed for the portions of the regulation that concern the permit application and modification process. The Department proposes to revise the permit application process to correspond with the process found in Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission Regulation No. 8, Administrative Procedures, which governs other permits issued by the Department. The proposed amendments will also clarify which permit modifications will be deemed minor modifications and will not require a public notice and comment period.
- b. The proposed amendments will provide for testing and review procedures to ensure appropriate updates to the waste management plan for the permitted facilities.
- c. The proposed revisions will clarify certain record-keeping requirements that will allow more flexibility to the permit holder, while still providing data to the Department to ensure the waste management plan is protective of the environment.

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
