PETITION TO INITIATE RULEMAKING TO AMEND REGULATION NO. 5: LIQUID ANIMAL WASTE MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

DEQ proposes to initiate this rulemaking to make permanent the moratorium on confined animal operations of a certain size in the Buffalo National River Watershed in accordance with the Governor's request; to incorporate statutory changes from Acts 910 and 315 of 2019 passed by the General Assembly that amend the name of DEQ and references to rules; and to make minor stylistic revisions.
