MOTION TO ADOPT AMENDMENTS TO REGULATION NO. 6

- On August 24, 2012, the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (hereinafter "APCEC" or "Commission") granted ADEQ's Petition to Initiate Rulemaking to Amend Regulation No. 6.
- 2. A public hearing was held at ADEQ Headquarters in North Little Rock, Arkansas on October 16, 2012. The public comment period ended on October 30, 2012. One (1) written comment was submitted during the public comment period and two (2) oral comments were received at the public hearing.
- 3. Pursuant to APCEC Reg. 8.814, ADEQ submits the following documents supporting adoption of the regulation to the Commission for its consideration:

4. A previously adopted chapter of Reg. 6 was inadvertently omitted from the copy of the regulation that was submitted at initiation of the rulemaking. Chapter Six, regarding the Lake Maumelle Basin, was duly adopted by the Commission on May 27, 2010 by Minute Order No. 10-19. Chapters Six, Seven and Eight, as revised by that Minute Order, are included in Exhibit C.

WHEREFORE, ADEQ prays that the Commission adopt the Proposed Minute Order adopting the amendments to Regulation No. 6.
