Thank you for your comments; however there is no reference in your remarks to the topic you wish to address, other than "dry fork creek," which is not a subject either the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission or the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality has an open public comment period on at this time.

Currently, the Commission has open public comment periods involving proposed changes to two of its regulations which involve water quality issues: Proposed changes to Regulation 6 drafted by the Department (Docket Number 13-007-R), and proposed third-party changes by the City of Huntsville to Regulation 2 (Docket Number 13-006-R).
