Subject: Comments on Reguation 6

I have become aware of the many failures of the small sewage treatment plants which have been set up in Arkansas.

Sewage treatment plants need to have professionals employed to manage them.

They should not be allowed to discharge into streams where at any time of the year their output is greater than 10 % of the stream flow.

Any densely planned subdivision which can construct a discharge pipe to a city sewer plant for no more than three times the cost of constructing a small treatment plant should be required to do this rather than constructing a small treatment system.

A requirement should be established forbidding discharge of a treatment plant upstream of swimming areas for a safe number of miles upstream.

Regulation six should be strengthened to require these things.

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
