Yes _____ No ___ X This proposed revision of Regulation No. 9 creates permit fees for new general permits for the land application of drilling fluids and the construction, operation and closure of pits associated with oil and gas exploration and production issued by the Water Division of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ). The permit fees are very similar to what a permit applicant would expect to pay for an individual permit for the same activity. The other proposed amendments to Regulation No. 9 clarify the fee structure for certain general permits issued by the Air and Solid Waste Divisions of ADEQ, but does not increase existing permit fees. In total, the financial impact of the proposed amendments will be minimal. 2.
