STATEMENT OF BASIS AND PURPOSE

OF THE DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

The Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission is vested with general authority to make and amend rules in Ark. Code Ann. § 8-01-203(b)(1)(A).

The purpose of the revisions to Regulation 19 is to include changes in certain titles—
"Regulation" to "Rule" and "Department" to "Division"—in order to bring Arkansas Pollution
Control and Ecology Commission Regulation No. 19 into conformity with Act 315 of 2019 and
the Transformation and Efficiencies Act of 2019. Because all instances of "regulation" were
changed to "rule" when referring to rules promulgated by Arkansas entities, the definitions for
Rule 8, Rule 18, and Rule 26 were added. These definitions ensure continuity of references to these
rules, which have not yet been revised to change the term "regulation" to "rule." There are no
substantive changes included in this proposed amendment.

The amendments to Regulation 19 are necessary to serve the public interest and ensure compliance with state law.
