**RESPONSIVE SUMMARY FOR THE REPEAL OF
REGULATION NO. 25, LEAD-BASED PAINT ACTIVITIES**

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated § 8-4-202(d)(4)(C) and Regulation No. 8.815, a responsive summary groups public comments into similar categories and explains why the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (“Commission”) accepts or rejects the rationale for each category.

On September 14, 2012, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (“ADEQ”) filed a Petition to Initiate Rulemaking to Repeal Regulation No. 25, Lead-Based Paint Activities. Commission member Joseph Bates acted as Hearing Officer and conducted a public hearing on November 13, 2012. The public comment period was extended to December 20, 2012. ADEQ received no comments regarding the proposed repeal of Regulation No. 25 during the public comment period.

Conclusion:

No written or oral comments were submitted regarding the proposed repeal of Regulation No. 25.
