## RESPONSE TO COMMENTS

On August 22, 2014, the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission (hereinafter "APC&EC") passed Minute Order 14-27, which initiated rulemaking procedures for amendments to APC&EC Regulation No. 30, the Remedial Action Trust Fund Hazardous Substances Site Priority List. A public hearing on the proposed changes was held on September 30, 2014. The public comment period closed on October 14, 2014.

One comment was received during the public hearing. This comment is set out below, with the Department's response following.

## Comment #1:

The Arkansas Department of Health requested the Norphlet Chemical site be added to the list of Superfund sites due to the fact it is within one-half miles of the Norphlet Waterworks Well #3 and the Wellhead Protection Area.

## **Response:**

The Department acknowledges this comment. MacMillan Ring Free Oil, a/k/a Norphlet Chemical, was placed on the National Priority List under Final Rule #58 on or about May 8, 2014, therefore this request has no impact on the proposed rulemaking.
