EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS: Owners and operators of tire collection centers or mobile tire processing equipment shall prepare and provide to the Division a written emergency preparedness plan at the time of submitting a notification.

- Proof of notification to local fire protection authorities of the emergency plan;
- Proof of a written mosquito control plan;
- Map showing location of fire or other emergency equipment; and
- Disclosure Statement

c.	Facility Operation
1.	Description of the facility's operation, including how tires will be collected, stored, recycled, disposed, and processed.
2.	Description of how each of the storage requirements in Rule 36.1508 or 36.1602 will be met.
3.	Copy of the emergency preparedness manual for the facility.
4.	Copy of the fire safety survey.
5.	Description of how 75% of the annual accumulation of tires at the <u>mobile tire processing facility</u> will be processed and removed for disposal or recycling.
6.	Completed closure plan for the <u>mobile tire processing facility</u> as required by Rule 36.1613.
7.	Proof of financial responsibility for <u>mobile tire processing facility</u> as required by Rule 36.1615.
8.	Permit fee required by Rule 36.1507 & 36.1601 (must be included with the general permit notification).

6. Certification

To the best of my knowledge, I certify the above information provided is true and correct. I am aware that statements made in this form and attached information are part of an application for a tire collection center or mobile tire processing equipment facility permit from the Division of Environmental Quality (DEQ) and certifies that the information in this application is true, correct, and complete to the best of his/her knowledge and belief. Further, the undersigned agrees to comply with the provisions of Act 317, Rule 36, Arkansas statutes, and all rules and regulations of DEQ. DEQ shall be notified prior to the sale of legal transfer of the facility.
