You, the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ), have agreed to perform investigative drilling around the C&H ponds to determine if, as suggested by ERI studies, the ponds are leaking. As a taxpayer and resident of Arkansas and as a kayaker who enjoys the pristine natural wonders of the Buffalo National River, I have the right to instruct you on how to honor my best interests in this matter:

- 1) Make the drilling depth 120' as has been recommended.
- 2) Use a minimum of three borings, not one. Two additional core borings would not materially add to the cost.
- 3) If you persist in including a BCRET observer, then include only one member of the BCRET team and then only with the presence of Dr. Bert Fisher, as a BRWA observer. Your selection of Mr Hubbard as an observer is only acceptable if no BCRET team members are present.
- 4) Dye tracing must be done before the borehole is closed.
- 5) ADEQ must disclose what you plan to do, if waste is found in the soil or bedrock.
