Subject: Hog farm waste comment drilling/testing comment

1. Why is the drilling depth to only 100' when 120' has been recommended? Drill to 120 feet or more to get accurate results.
2. ADEQ needs to complete at least three borings to get accurate results of pond leakage. One would not provide adequate results in the complex substrata near the hog factory.
3. Allow Dr. Bert Fisher to attend the borings. ADEQ has already shown a repeated tendency to lie and deceive. Please demonstrate an attempt at regaining the public trust by allowing truly transparent drilling and water/transitivity testing on the operation -- not hidden insider determinations only. Your kids and grandkids will likely play in a water body you had the chance to protect. Don't let your progeny have to experience the agony of raising malformed, disabled kids because you helped turn our beautiful state into a wasteland.
4. Allow dye tracing before the borehole is closed. Since previous dye tracing research in the area near C&H has indicated that groundwater movement at an astonishing velocity of approximately 2700 feet per day, the plan should include dye tracing before the borehole is closed.
5. Come up with an honest, legitimate plan for remediation if contamination is found. What does ADEQ plan to do if waste is found in the soil or bedrock?
