As part of the transparency, I believe ADEQ wishes to manifest, I, as a citizen, expect the following requests to be met.

1. Prior to the drilling, please reveal what steps ADEQ will take if hog waste is discovered in the soil or bedrock underneath.
2. Drill to 120 feet as has been recommended rather than just 100 feet you have announced.
3. Drill three bore holes rather than just one. Citing added cost is not credible; the main cost is getting the equipment to the site..
4. Conduct dye tracing using the completed bore hole before it is filled back in.
5. I cannot imagine why after all that has been said and done you would not allow Bert Fisher onsite. It is simply unacceptable to not have the preferred observer of the Buffalo Coalition present. The Mr. Hubbard you chose you did so with no input from the Buffalo Coalition. At the July 8 meeting ADEQ representative said" oh having other observers is a safety issue. We will have to limit who can be there." But now you are allowing BCRET observers but not Bert Fisher.
6. Finally and most importantly: Regardless of the outcome of this study and how it is conducted the necessity for doing so goes back to the all too apparent fact that all of these points, all the money the State has spent and continues to spend on this one hog factory show clear evidence that this hog factory farm and others like it have no place in the sensitive karst terrain of the Buffalo River Watershed.
