- 3. Given the large amounts of trash that's routinely collected from Fourche Creek, how is it that ADEQ could not conclude that urban runoff is a source--if not the primary source--of its contaminants?
- 4. It is well known that sewage flows into the creek during major floods. E. coli has been documented. What data support ADEQ's decision on primary and secondary contact?
